HIKING PREPARATIONS

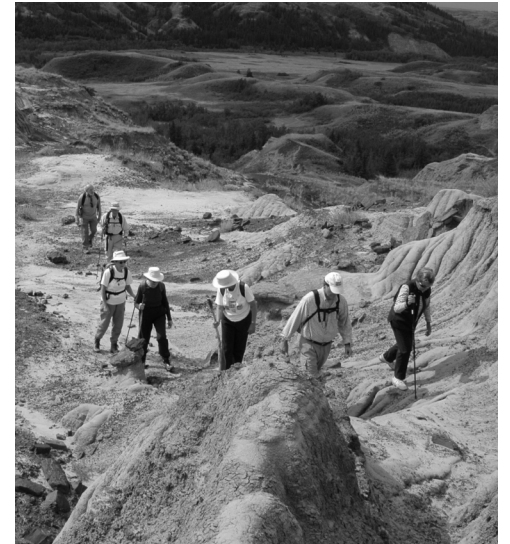
We highly recommend that you wear hiking boots or good walking shoes and suitable clothing for the weather you expect to be out in.
